



Lucerne Festival Young at the 2018 Summer Festival

Lucerne Festival Young's programming for 2018 offers concerts for all age groups. From 12 to 18 August 2018, children and teenagers from different cultures will gather together for the first time for an international orchestra camp at Lucerne Festival. During a week of intense rehearsal, they will work on a concert program which they will then present in the Concert Hall the day after the Festival opening. The International Orchestra Camp will take place as part of a three-year cooperation between Lucerne Festival and Superar Suisse and is supported by the Hilti Foundation. For the Special Event Day, composer-in-residence Fritz Hauser has conceived a new work: *Schraffur für das KKL Luzern* ("Crosshatching for the KKL Lucerne"), a performance piece that will take place inside and around the KKL and in which adults and children will both participate. The Family Concert "Domande - Fragen" ("Questions"), based on Jostein Gaarder, will be performed with the Teatro Dimitri for concertgoers ages 8 and up. The Luxembourg-based director Dan Tanson, this summer's "artiste étoile," is already familiar to Lucerne audiences from his previous contributions here, including the staged concert "Drumblebee" and the first-ever Young Performance production, "Heroïca" (which makes its return to the program). Tanson is also creating a new production called "Senegalliarde" which features traditional music from Senegal. The of Central Swiss Youth Symphony Orchestra (ZJSO), led by Joseph Sieber, will stage a Late Night concert at the Concert Hall aimed at young audiences.
